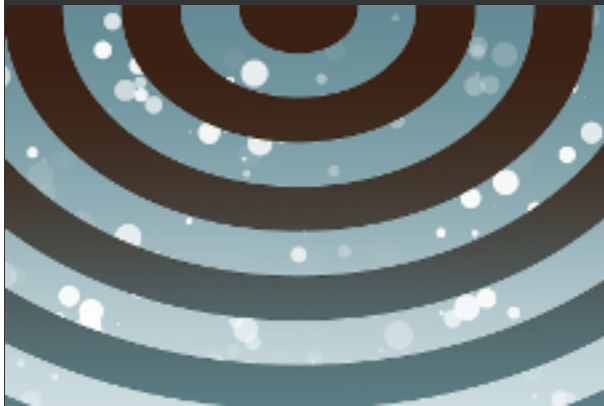

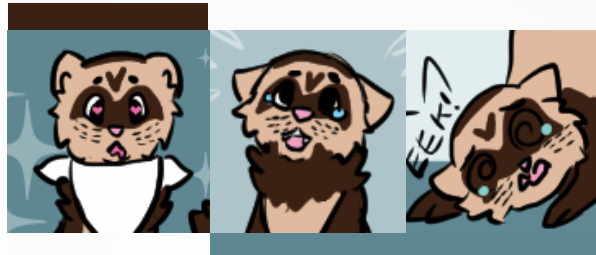

Ferrets are not starter pets, they require just as much work as a dog or cat, if not more! Here are some basic things you should know about them!

- Ferrets can live anywhere from 7 to 10 years!
- Ferrets need to spend most of their time outside their cages running around and being social!
- Box training is not always possible with ferrets and cleaning up often is necessary!

Ferrets are not very sturdy pets and are very good at getting hurt and hurting themselves if not watched over properly! Here are ways they can become unwell.

- Ferrets love to eat things they shouldn't and are prone to choking. Thier areas should be tidy!
- Recliners can kill a ferret and they should be kept completely separate.
- Ferrets can die of flea infestations and can't always be treated in regular ways.

While not to most expensive pet out there, ferrets are still somewhat pricey. You should always consider if you have the funds to support a ferret!

- Ferrets are strict carnivores and can get cancer from the wrong kind of diet
- Ferrets need toys to keep occupied and out of trouble
- Rabbit cages are not suitable ferret cages
- Ferrets often count as an exotic pet at the vet!
